### **University of Brighton – Social Sciences Day**

We are pleased to inform you that the year 12 sociology students have been invited to visit the University of Brighton, to take part in a Social Sciences Day. The trip will be held on Wednesday 14 October 2015 and will give students an opportunity to experience what it is like to attend Brighton University as an undergraduate student studying Social Science.

The day will include a series of lectures and seminars on social issues under the title of 'Which lives matter?' and will give students the opportunity to participate in discussions and debates with current university students and lecturers, as well as gaining a deeper understanding of student life.

Students must meet at Lancing station at 8.50am, in time to catch the train at 9.00am to Falmer train station; on their arrival at 9.30am they will then walk a short distance to the University, using the footpath. Students need to ensure that they are registered and organised for the day, which will start at 10.00am. Students will be provided with refreshments and lunch.

Although there is no cost for entry to this event, students will be responsible for buying their own train ticket at the cost of £6.70. There is financial assistance available for those who qualify. Should you require further information, please contact our Finance Manager, Mrs Emsley.

3.00pm	End of sessions
3.05pm	Walk to Falmer Station
3.21pm	Travel by train back to Lancing station
4.04pm	Arrive at Lancing station, where students will make their own way home.
