IMPERIAL WAR MUSEUM TRIP – THURSDAY 30 JUNE

I am pleased to offer our year 9 GCSE History students the opportunity to take part in a trip to the Imperial War Museum, in London on Thursday 30 June.

This trip will consolidate and extend students' understanding of World War Two and specifically, the Holocaust. The trip will include a guided tour of the world famous Holocaust exhibition, as well as access to relics and artefacts from the exhibition, accompanied by a museum curator, who will give an interactive lecture on the Holocaust.

Students will be departing the Academy at 8.00am and travelling by coach to The Imperial War Museum and will return at approximately 5.00pm, dependant on the traffic conditions.

Students will be required to wear full school uniform and bring a packed lunch. Those eligible for free school meals should pick up their packed lunch from the canteen before leaving the Academy. It is recommended that the students bring a waterproof jacket and suntan lotion depending on the weather conditions.

Although your child has been selected for this trip, there are limited spaces available. Therefore, this trip will be on a first come, first served basis. The cost of the trip is £23.00 and is payable via WisePay. Please note that there is financial assistance available for those who qualify.
