Attending this event does not mean that students are automatically going to university, but supports them in exploring the options available to them.

The students should meet SRWA staff at Lancing train station at **09:15 sharp**. The train is scheduled to depart Lancing train station at 09:30 and due to arrive back at Lancing train station at approximately 13:13.

We are booking a group train ticket having successfully negotiated a significant discount with Southern Rail and we kindly request a voluntary contribution of £2.40 per student towards the cost which can be paid via WisePay.

There may also be an opportunity for them to purchase lunch if they would prefer, so they should bring some money with them in order to do so.
