ASPIRE DAY - TUESDAY 28 NOVEMBER 2017

We would like to inform you that the focus for our next Aspire day will be on sex and relationships.

The programme will follow the normal school timetable with sessions delivered by students' regular class teachers. This helps to create a safe environment within which we can discuss sometimes sensitive topics. The programme will include the following topics:

Relationships, Puberty, Sex and Contraception, STI's, Peer Pressure, E-safety, Bullying, Consent and the Law, Exploitation and Extremism, Family Set-Ups, Risks in Social Situations and Female Genital Mutilation (year 9's only).

Our priorities for the Aspire day are to ensure that students are educated on safe sex for their future, on how to stay safe online and to prevent indecent exposure. All of the content will be age appropriate based on the PSHE Association guidelines.
