Dear Parent/Carer

YEAR 7 CAMPING TRIP – JULY 2018

We are delighted to announce the plans for our Year 7 camping trip which will be held during Activities Week in July 2018. The trip will be a fantastic opportunity for our younger students to develop independence and enhance their confidence through working with their peers within teams. In previous years, all our students have come away with new friends and fantastic stories to tell.

We will leave the Academy at **9.30am on Wednesday 18 July and return at 5.00pm on Friday 20 July**, giving the students three days and two nights camping. We will be camping at the Broadstone Warren Scout Site and Activity Centre in East Sussex. You can visit their website at: <http://www.broadstonewarren.org.uk>. The facilities are brilliant – the site provides the camping equipment and also a cooking tent, so our students only need to bring a sleeping bag and their appetite!

The students will be supported by kind and friendly teachers as well as energetic and experienced activity instructors. We plan for the students to do six activities per day. There are a wide range of activities on offer at the camp from abseiling to archery, and zip wiring to a very tall leap of faith!

The total cost of the trip will be an estimated £160.00 per student, depending on the number of students attending, this includes travel by executive coach and full board accommodation, as well as the itinerary that the students will be following. The cost is broken down at £46.16 per student for board and lodgings, and a voluntary contribution of £113.84 for the travel and excursions. Please note that if all parents who are able do not make the full voluntary contribution, then it is likely the trip will have to be cancelled. If there are exceptional cases of hardship, the Academy will support costs through the Pupil Premium grant for disadvantaged students. Please contact the Finance Office in confidence to discuss this further.

Please note that this cost may change depending on uptake and a further letter confirming your child's place and the final cost will follow once we have received all the reply slips. A non-refundable deposit of £40.00, payable via WisePay, will be required by 9 February, and the instalment plan is as follows; £40.00 by 29 March, £40.00 by 25 May and £40.00 by 29 June. There are 65 places available, which will be allocated on a first come, first served basis.

Your child may wish to take a small amount of pocket money to buy snacks or souvenirs from the camp shop.

We should be grateful if you would kindly complete the attached reply slip and return it to Miss English by 9 February.
