YEAR 7 CAMPING TRIP – JULY 2019

We are delighted to invite your child to take part in a camping trip in the summer term. This is a wonderful experience for our year 7 students to develop independence and enhance their confidence through working with their peers within teams. In previous years, all of our students have come away with new friends and fantastic stories to tell. Having experienced previous SRWA camp trips, I know this will be a fantastic opportunity for our students.

The trip will be held during the Activity Days in the last week of term. Students who do not go on the camping trip will take part in our annual sponsored walk on the Tuesday, and Sports Day on the Thursday. On the Wednesday, students can choose from a range of other trips, some of which bear a cost, or an in-school activity. For students going on the camping trip we will leave at 9.30am on Tuesday 16 July and return at 3.00pm on Thursday 18 July, giving the students three days and two nights camping. All students will be in the Academy on Friday for the leaving assembly and end of term.

We will be camping at the Broadstone Warren Scout Site and Activity Centre in East Sussex. You can visit their website at: <http://www.broadstonewarren.org.uk/>. The facilities are fantastic – the site provides the camping equipment and also a cooking tent, so all our students need to bring is a sleeping bag and their appetite!

The students will be supported by kind and friendly teachers as well as energetic and experienced activity instructors. We plan for the students to do six activities per day. There are a wide range of activities on offer at the camp from abseiling to archery, and zip wiring to a very tall leap of faith!

The exact cost is not yet known and will be dependent on student numbers and the activity schedule. However, we know from previous years that this is likely to be in the region of £165.00. A further letter confirming your child's place, the final cost and repayment schedule will follow once we have received all the reply slips. Your child may also wish to take a small amount of pocket money to buy snacks or souvenirs from the camp shop. The trip can be paid in full or by instalments via WisePay.

If you would like your child to attend the camp trip, we should be grateful if you would kindly complete the attached reply slip and return it by 30 November, together with a non-refundable deposit of £40.00 paid by WisePay.
