PSHCE DAY – MONDAY 20 JULY

We would like to inform you that for our next PSHCE day, our students in years 7 to 10 will experience three sessions whereby they are separated into year and gender groups.

The morning session will focus on learning attributes where they identify the skills they need in order to be successful in their learning journey. The second session will be looking at E-safety and how they can keep safe on the internet, a crucial lesson in this day and age. Then, to end the day, students will have a session on sex education; there will be a 50 minute session with their teacher on sexually transmitted infections and a 50 minute session with the School Nurse on contraception.

Our priority during these sessions is to educate our students on how to keep themselves safe and give them an awareness of the possible harm that comes with unprotected sex. We will also be looking at peer pressure and how to deal with this in order to make sure our students are equipped to make informed choices. During the session with the School Nurse, there will be an opportunity for students to participate in a condom demonstration for years 8 to 10. All of the sessions will be planned and implemented in a safe and sensitive way.

We fully understand that you may not want your child to participate in one or more of these sessions due to various reasons. If this is the case then please indicate this on the attached reply slip and we will make alternative provision for your child during that chosen session.
